7. Report on the Sibenik Congress 2023 (Trotic)

 \rightarrow It was held 3-5 May of 2023 in Sibenik convention center

 \rightarrow The rooms for the working groops were too small for the many participants. This should be taken into account when planning for the Vienna Congress.

 \rightarrow The congress comprised 6 Keynote speakers, 7 structured sessions, 158 oral lectures in 17 themes. Also 2 regional panels and 56 poster presentations.

- \rightarrow EFAS general assembly was held during the congress.
- \rightarrow EFAS lifetime award to Stig Arlinger (Sweden).
- \rightarrow CME 18 points.
- \rightarrow Total expenses 277 968.64 euro, 4 000 euro profit to EFAS.

8. Report on progress for Vienna Congress 2025 (Sprinzl) and future congresses

(Denmark 2027, Neher)

Vienna Congress (2025)

- \rightarrow Dr. Adrian Piec report on the preparation for the next congress.
- \rightarrow PCO: AIM group (Lisa Stern)
- \rightarrow Congress venue with places of up to 600 guests. Palace Niederosterich.
- \rightarrow The largest hall can take 330 people.
- \rightarrow Work with sponsors (3 already clear)
- \rightarrow Two keynotes ready. 3 stuctured session themes.

 \rightarrow Discussions about the WG: 5 hours on the first afternoon that is not in competetion with the rest of the congress.

 \rightarrow Posters are proposed to be on screens. It was stressed that the posters should be physical and there should be specific poster times.

Denmark (2027)

 \rightarrow Tobias Neher gives and update on the EFAS 2027 preparation.

 \rightarrow A new proposal of the venue is given with lower costs. The cost reduction is in the order of 50% lower. New dates are early june.

 \rightarrow There is a general approval from the GA for the new proposal.

 \rightarrow Open discussion about how to divide between travel awards for conferences and projects.
